He also was busy learning dance, voice, and drama. By the time he was 16 he was a working theatrical professional with many credits to his name. He was on his way.

Nothing would make Tim happier than helping Metro Atlanta rising 10,11, and 12 graders grow and develop in their area of the performing arts! The Tim Redovian Memorial Fund has been set up to help provide financial assistance so students can benefit from a professional learning experience outside of their school that will help them to grow as actors, singers, dancers, and instrumentalists.
