Tim was only nine years old when he took his first acting class and discovered his love for performing! On his way home that day he announced that one day he wanted to be on Broadway. From then on, with the help of his parents, he began taking classes and attending programs that would help him develop his many talents. In high school Tim attended the DeKalb Center for the Performing Arts at Avondale High School (now DSA) where he was a member of the National Honor Society and a participant in the Governor's Honors Program. He also was busy learning dance, voice, and drama. By the time he was 16 he was a working theatrical professional with many credits to his name. He was on his way.
